Expert committee. Architecture and Sustainability: Outstanding Qualities

The scientific committee emphasises the following points from the text provided by the architects: «_ The building illustrates the modern architectural approach of building on instead of building new. (...) Sustainability, regionality and craftsmanship are the most important design criteria on the inside. The roof of the exhibition rooms, for example, was clad in wood; the silver fir trees required for this were felled in the town's own forest.

The façade and roof landscape thus not only represent a valuable contribution to modern construction in a historical setting, but also the exemplary use of renewable and regional raw materials. »
