Expert committee. Architecture and Sustainability: Outstanding Qualities

The scientific committee highlights that the Food Kiosk presents a work built with « 98% recycled construction materials, Net Zero Waste Level 1 (for example, 100% construction waste avoided from landfill) and Net Zero Embodied Carbon Level 3 (it will be the first certified embodied carbon project in South Africa). » Moreover, the committee extracts from the text provided by the architect: «The building applies passive design for all aspects of cooling, heating, and ventilation. Appropriate orientation of the building allows maximum light / and heating of the building while deep opening, sliding doors and pergolas ensure control of heat gain. »
