

2024 WORKSHOP AREA TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. PRESENTATION

The 2024 Construmat Workshop Area is an open space for training meetings and practical learning workshops, led by professionals. The activities of this area will focus on practical and interactive content, in addition to demonstrations and applications.

By means of the Workshop Area, Construmat seeks to promote learning and career development of professionals in the sector. By sharing technical content, we aim to give tools and solutions to professionals in the sector.

This space is for:

- Construction workers/carpenters and joiners
- Building maintainers
- Solar energy installers
- Renovators
- Restorers

2. FORMAT OF THE PRESENTATION

This space is for holding **Workshops and practical demonstrations**. It has a low stage, a central desk and electricity supply. It is not designed for lectures or presentations solely in digital format. It is ideal for presentations to include a demonstration or practical component.

Only projects that include a hands-on demonstration of a process or technique

are eligible for selection.

Presentations shall last for **60 min**; we recommend allowing 10 min for Q&A.

3. THEMES

The cornerstone of the Construmat Congress is promoting the sustainability of the construction industry. All proposals whose core themes are sustainability and innovation will be valued positively.

Proposals must be in the following categories:

- Insulation, waterproofing, coatings and paints
- Lifts, escalators and stair lifts
- Bathrooms
- Wood, metal and PVC carpentry
- Locksmithing and metalwork
- Kitchens
- Connected House: ICT, the IoT and home automation
- HVAC
- Water management
- Energy management and capture
- Lighting and electricity
- Machinery, tools and equipment
- Furnishing and interior design
- Walls, structures, façades and roofs
- Flooring and coatings
- Prevention of occupational hazards, protection and safety on the site
- Solar protection
- Urban planning, landscaping and outdoor space
- Glass

4. SELECTION PROCESS

The proposals will be evaluated according to the following selection criteria:

- **Format:** degree of interaction with the audience, creative formats and a high level of interactivity as demonstrations and applications of products.
- **Relevance:** importance of the proposed training for the industry
- **Innovation:** state of the art, cutting edge

5. CALENDAR

Opening of the “Call for Workshops”: 16 November 2023

Deadline: 20 February 2024 - midnight CET. No proposals will be accepted after this deadline has expired

Evaluation: 16 to 21 January 2024.

Notification: 21 February to 10 March 2024. The slots are allocated by the organisation and are subject to change without prior notice.

Confirmation: From 5 to 10 March, 2024 (midnight CET)

Publication: All of the selected projects will be published on the Construmat website and schedule

7. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

Proposals must be submitted as per the information requirements stipulated on the candidate submission form posted along with this Call for Workshops, available at the following link:

Submission of proposals online is open until 20 February 2024, midnight CET.

The organization is unable to provide FLT's, pallet jacks or other machinery necessary for the activity proposed by the exhibitor in the Workshop area.
