TOWARDS ZERO WASTE INITIATIVE

What do you need to know?

This year, as has been the practice since the <u>Towards Zero Waste initiative</u> was launched in 2015, Smart City Expo World Congress (SCEWC) aims to <u>reduce</u> waste generated and save resources at the event. In order to achieve this goal, we engaged in several activities that last year enabled us to compensate 203,97 CO2e emissions, as well as preventing 2,134 kg of plastic waste, recycling a total amount of 9,180 kg of carpet and 14,000 kg of wood.

We're free of single-use plastics

In 2024, we'll get rid of single-use plastic through three main actions:

- All drinks for sale within the venue will be in glass containers, not plastic bottles, cups or cans
- Our catering menus will be adapted to avoid using products wrapped or packaged in plastic

We're carbon neutral

All emissions generated by the event are offset, for example by sourcing energy from solar panels or creating credits to produce wind energy in other locations.

We encourage participants

All lanyards, passes and pass holders are made from recycled materials, and can be discarded at the return point to be recycled again after the event. Recycling bins are also distributed throughout the venue, making it easy for visitors to contribute to our sustainability efforts.

We encourage our exhibitors

We inform them of what they can do to reduce their waste production, we have an initiative to reuse all materials of their booth by donating them to social organizations, and we offer a waste collection service (paper/cardboard, packaging and glass) at the end of each day.

We don't waste food

Leftover food is donated to the NGO Nutrition Without Borders, to be distributed to community kitchens. Containers for separating organic waste will also be available at all restaurants and dining areas around the venue.



We save on paper

QR code points are set up at strategic places throughout the venue for downloading the congress app. Magazines related to event topics are also available for download, and all paper used at stands will be collected for recycling at the end of the event.

We help reforest the planet

We ask them to contribute in a new reforestation initiative in collaboration with Plant for the Planet. All money raised from the donations achieved will be given to the Planting for Doñana reforestation project.

Plant for the Planet - Make a donation

We give support to the most fragile

Our stores located in the Avenue sell event branded t-shirts, bags and bottles. All the money from the visitor's purchase is used for solidarity actions.

We encourage car-free transportation

We encourage the use of public transport, as well as non-polluting means of transport, offering a guarded parking lot for bicycles and scooters. Lines L9S and L1OS connect Fira Gran Via Venue to the airport and the city center. In the Level -1 of the South Access of the venue, there is a tunnel that connects directly to the Metro Station Fira.
