

Rules for Works Built

BARCELONA BUILDING CONSTRUMAT 2017 AWARDS FOR WORKS BUILT

1. WHAT WORKS CAN BE NOMINATED TO PARTICIPATE

Works of architecture, urban planning and new plant infrastructure or interventions in existing works are eligible for these awards, finished between 1 January 2015 and 31 December 2016, developed, planned, directed or built by any agent in the construction process from Spain, Portugal and Andorra in any country around the world.

Categories:

- Architecture.
- Infrastructures.

2. WHO CAN NOMINATE THE WORKS

The works you wish to nominate for the awards may be submitted by any agent in the construction process—development, planning, project or execution management, construction—who participated in them. The nominator is responsible for the accuracy of the information. Works deemed appropriate may be submitted, but a registration must be issued for each proposal.

3. REGISTRATION AND DOCUMENTATION

It is necessary to pre-register by completing the online form provided on the website <http://www.construmat.com/es/premios-construmat-form> before 23:59 GTM+2 on 15 March 2017.

Note: The pre-registration deadline is extended until March 31 before 23:59, GTM +2.

Once the pre-registration has been completed, a link will be sent via email to submit file documents describing the nominated works:

- Worksheet: Complete the online form.
- Final completion certificate issued by the relevant management team in JPG or PDF format, this must not exceed 5 MB
- Panel A2 (vertical orientation), in PDF format which must not exceed 5 MB and include the following information:
 - Photo(s) reflecting the works' architectural and material quality.
 - Graphic documentation of the works: Floor plans, elevations, cross-sections.
 - Description of strategies/relevant construction solutions: axonometry and/or construction details.

Registration is **FREE**, it can only be carried out online and is only valid if the documentation is submitted within the time periods specified in these rules.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The awards organisation reserves the right to reproduce the finalists and award-winners' information and images in all documented media deemed necessary. The proposals submitted in this call and not selected as finalists shall not be made public.

5. PARTICIPATION AND QUERIES DEADLINES

Pre-registration of proposals will end at 23:59 GTM+2 on 31 March 2017.

The deadline for submission of the documentation describing the works ends at 23:59, GTM+2 on 17 April 2017.

Note: The registration deadline is extended until April 21 before 23:59, GTM +2.

6. JURY AND TECHNICAL SECRETARIAT

The jury will be made up of renowned professionals and academics selected by the Mies van der Rohe Foundation, centre for research, discussion and promotion of architectural culture.

Any additional information requested by the Jury should be made available.

7. SELECTION CRITERIA

The Jury will consider the following criteria to give its verdict:

- The architectural quality of the works.
- The solvency of the project's technical specifications and its ability to respond to the sector's new challenges.
- Material innovation
- The sustainability of the works at all stages of the construction process, in response to functional, technical and environmental constraints.

8. COMMUNICATION

The Technical Secretariat of the Awards will notify participants of the finalist proposals two weeks before the Show.

9. AWARD

The Jury shall award the Barcelona Building Construmat 2017 Awards for Works Built from among the final proposals by selecting a winner for the architecture category and a winner for the infrastructure category. If appropriate, mentions may be made in both categories.

The Award shall be given to the agent nominating the works.

The prize consists of an award and a certificate for each of the agents who participated in the works.

The finalists will receive a diploma.

Awards may not be declared void or granted ex aequo.

10. INCIDENTS

It will be the Jury's sole responsibility to resolve any issues that may arise regarding the granting of the awards. The Jury's decisions are unquestionable.

11. PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The reading of the verdict and the awards ceremony will be held at a public ceremony on Wednesday, 24 May 2017.

12. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

Participation in these awards implies acceptance of these rules.
