










Barcelona Building Construmat is built around innovation, knowledge and business development



New materials





Barcelona Building Construmat is held at the Gran Via Exhibition Centre, one of Europe's most modern show venues that is committed to sustainability

The Gran Via Exhibition Centre was designed by Japanese architect Toyo Ito, the winner of the 2013 Pritzker Architecture Prize.





Gran Via Venue Centre

This venue is characterised by its design, functionality and commitment to sustainability: it houses one of the largest rooftop-based solar parks. Gran Via has 25,900 solar panels that generate 5.86 GWh of electricity a year, which prevents the emission of more than 2,200 tons of CO2.

Its eight pavilions are connected by a tunnel that channels visitor traffic and it has the most advanced technical and logistical features. The gourmet restaurant Nuclo is located in the large Europa Hall. Barcelona Building Construmat will be held in Hall 2 of the venue.

The exhibition centre is located in a new area of commercial development close to Barcelona airport and has excellent connections to Barcelona's public transport network.

Towards 0 Waste

Barcelona Building Construmat is committed to sustainability in line with the European Commission's Circular Economy Strategy.

Towards 0 Waste is a pioneering initiative for reducing waste and saving resources while the show is being held.
